DAY 1 : CITY OF ORIGIN - MARRAKECH

Arrival at Marrakech airport.

Reception and transfer to the selected hotel.

Departure with our guide in a buggy for a visit to the Majorelle Garden. Discovery of the wonderful history of the famous Majorelle garden, how the great designer Yves Saint-Laurent had its architecture restored, walk through the shady streets and enjoy an oasis of exotic plants and beautiful gardens in the desert city of Marrakech, learn about its architecture from French influence and his connection to iconic designer Yves Saint Laurent. Back to the hotel.

DAY 2 : MARRAKECH

Breakfast at the hotel,

Departure with our guide to the prestigious Koutoubia Mosque, one of the most beautiful mosques in the Muslim West. Of Almohad origin and Hispano-Moorish style, it is made up of a wide central nave and sixteen parallel naves.

Later, we will head to the Saadies tombs, they date from the end of the 16th century and are located in a closed garden that is accessed through a small corridor.

After visiting this place we will go to the Bahia Palace, from the 19th century with large gardens and beautifully decorated patios. It was the residence of the French resident General Lyautey.

Continuation to Jemaa El Fnaa Square, which is the central square of Marrakech and the most important place in the medina. In it the public life of Marrakech takes place both day and night. The best thing about Jemaa el Fna Square is the transformation it undergoes throughout the day. Time to enjoy lunch in a good restaurant inside the Medina.

After lunch, entering through the Jemaa el Fna Square and touring the Souk through its dozens of labyrinthine streets. Here you can buy all kinds of clothes, spices, food, crafts and typical products. In the souk you will find artisans grouped by guilds: dyers, basket makers and ironmongers are some of the trades that meet in the Marrakech souk. Back to the hotel.

DAY 3 : MARRAKECH – DADES (272 KM)

Breakfast at the hotel,

Departure in the direction of Ouarzazate crossing the high atlas and the Tichka col 2,260mts of altutid, and we will see the kasbah of Ait Ben HADDOU, the famous place where several well-known films were filmed such as Asterix, Ibelix and Gladiator, among others. Lunch and rest in Ouarzazate. Then we will continue our route to the Palmeral de Skoura and the Valley of Roses, finally arriving at the valley of DADES. Dinner and accommodation at the Hotel.

DAY 4 : DADES – TODRA – MERZOUGA – DUNES DE ERG CHEBBI (255 km)

Breakfast and departure to the Todra Gorges to visit this geographical feature. Continuation of the route to Erfoud and finally the dunes of Erg Chebbi where you will have an afternoon determined to visit this great stretch of sand. They will be able to see sunset in the dunes one of the most impressive visual spectacles.

Dinner and accommodation in a nomadic bivouac in the dunes Magical night under millions of stars.







DAY 5 : MERZOUGA – MIDELT – FEZ (475 KM)

Breakfast at the hotel,

Departure to Fez via Rissani, the ancient economic capital of Morocco. Continuation to the palm valley of the Ziz, passing through Tafilalt and enjoying its panoramic visits. Arrival in Azrou, contemplating the wonderful landscapes of the Middle Atlas and the pig forest with a mandatory stop to see the monkeys that live in freedom. Then we will pass through Ifrane. Arrival in Fez.

Dinner and hotel accommodation.







DAY 6 : FEZ

Breakfast at the hotel,

Departure for the visit of Fez, cultural capital and the oldest of the imperial cities of the country.

9th century city that is a great medina, the best preserved in the Arab world, undergoing restoration and the largest living monument in all of Morocco, the largest urban area in the world without car traffic.

The Medina of Fez classified as world heritage by UNESCO has managed to preserve all its authenticity and its original stamp for more than 1200 years, the result of the mixture of various civilizations, Arab, Andalusian, Berber and Hebrew.

Strolling through the labyrinthine streets of Fez, transports you to past worlds in which potters, forgers and craftsmen coexist with the foreign visitor, who never ceases to be surprised by observing its people and smelling the multiple aromas and smells that flood the atmosphere of this city.

Approaching the Royal Palace and touring the Jewish quarter, the impressive Medina, with its typical shops and artisan neighborhoods, the exterior of the Mosque, the Al Bouanania Koranic school and the El Quaraouiyne University.

Lunch in a typical restaurant in the medina. We will discover from the outside the rich decoration of the Mosque of the Andalusians and the outside of the tomb of Moulay Idriss, to end with a beautiful panoramic view of Fez and its surroundings from one of the highest points of the city. Back to the hotel,

DAY 7 : FEZ – VOLUBILIS – MEKNES – RABAT (280 KM)

Breakfast at the hotel,

Departure to the Roman ruins of Volubilis, of Carthaginian origin (3rd century AD), the city, it was called Oulili, which seems to be a deformation of «oualili» ('oleanders' in Berber). Later, continuation towards Meknes, the Ismaili city, whose beauty is only comparable with its glorious history, is naturally privileged by the diversity of its geographical advantages. Meknes, an obligatory crossing point between the Atlantic plains and the eastern plateaus, between the Middle-North Atlas and the pre-Rif hills, you will be able to enjoy the splendor of the natural contrast. Imperial City of Morocco, Meknes, whose medina is classified as a World Heritage Site.

Visit of the city, linked to the name of Moulay Ismail, the great sultan of the Alouita dynasty, where we will observe the walled Medina of the city, the Bab Mansour gate and the Hedim square.

Lunch in the Medina,

Departure to Rabat, administrative capital of the country,

Arrival in Rabat,

Dinner and accommodation at the hotel,



DAY 8 : RABAT – CASABLANBCA (90 KM)

Breakfast at the hotel,

Departure for a visit to the administrative capital of Morocco,

Due to its cultural and historical value, the city has been declared a World Heritage Site by Unesco.

We will pass by the exteriors of the Royal Palace and its gardens, the Hassan tower and the Mausoleum of Mohamed V.

Continuation to Casablanca,

Arrival in Casablanca and lunch,

Visit the economic capital of the country, starting with visiting the exteriors of the Hassan II Mosque, one of the largest mosques in the world,

A pharaonic work that was paid for by all Moroccans in popular subscription. It is located on the beach near the port to the beach and the medina, and rises majestically topped by its minaret of more than 200 meters of altitude, the highest in the world. At its top, there is a laser beam that marks the direction of Mecca, with a range of 30 km. You visit the promenade and the modern part of the city. Continuation to the old Medina, next to the port, is the Medina of Casablanca, of less interest than the other imperial cities, having been destroyed by the earthquake of 1755. Transfer to your hotel,
