DAY 1: CITY OF ORIGIN - TANGIER

Arrival at Tangier airport.

Assistance and transfer to the selected hotel.

Departure with our guide for the visit of Tangier, the Moroccan capital of the Strait, a great city in North Africa and the gateway to the continent. It is located on the coast of the Strait of Gibraltar, at the western end of the bay of its name.

We will visit the Kasbah and the Medina. We will continue to Cape Spartel and the caves of Hercules, according to legend this was the grotto where Hercules rested after separating Europe from Africa.

Continuation to Chefchaouen


Lunch in the Medina,

We will leave the city of Chaouen with its spectacular blue buildings of different shades of its old town, as well as its cobbled and sloping streets, full of looms and leather goods.


Continuation to Fez,

DAY 4: FES

Breakfast at the hotel,

Departure for the visit of Fez, cultural capital and the oldest of the imperial cities of the country.

9th century city that is a great medina, the best preserved in the Arab world, undergoing restoration and the largest living monument in all of Morocco, the largest urban area in the world without car traffic.


The Medina of Fez classified as world heritage by UNESCO has managed to preserve all its authenticity and its original stamp for more than 1200 years, the result of the mixture of various civilizations, Arab, Andalusian, Berber and Hebrew. Strolling through the labyrinthine streets of Fez, transports you to past worlds in which potters, forgers and craftsmen coexist with the foreign visitor, who never ceases to be surprised by observing its people and smelling the multiple aromas and smells that flood the atmosphere of this city.

Approaching the Royal Palace and touring the Jewish quarter, the impressive Medina, with its typical shops and artisan neighborhoods, the exterior of the Mosque, the Al Bouanania Koranic school and the El Quaraouiyne University.

Lunch in a typical restaurant in the medina. We will discover from the outside the rich decoration of the Mosque of the Andalusians and the outside of the tomb of Moulay ldriss, to end with a beautiful panoramic view of Fez and its surroundings from one of the highest points of the city.

Back to the hotel,

Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.





DAY 5: FES - VOLUBILIS - MEKNES - RABAT

Breakfast at the hotel,

Departure to the Roman ruins of Volubilis, of Carthaginian origin (3rd century AD), the city, it was called Oulili, which seems to be a deformation of «oualili» ('oleanders' in Berber).

Later, continuation towards Meknes, the Ismaili city, whose beauty is only comparable with its glorious history, is naturally privileged by the diversity of its geographical advantages. Meknes, an obligatory crossing point between the Atlantic plains and the eastern plateaus, between the Middle-North Atlas and the pre-Rif hills, you will be able to enjoy the splendor of the natural contrast. Imperial City of Morocco, Meknes, whose medina is classified as a World Heritage Site. Visit of the city, linked to the name of Moulay Ismail, the great sultan of the Alaouite dynasty, where we will observe the walled Medina of the city, the Bab Mansour gate and the Hedim square.

Lunch in the Medina,

Departure to Rabat, administrative capital of the country,

Arrival in Rabat,

Dinner and accommodation at the hotel,







DAY 6: RABAT - CASABLANCA

Breakfast at the hotel,

Departure for a visit to the administrative capital of Morocco,

Due to its cultural and historical value, the city has been declared a World Heritage Site by Unesco. We will pass by the exteriors of the Royal Palace and its gardens, the Hassan tower and the Mausoleum of Mohamed V.

Continuation to Casablanca,

Arrival in Casablanca and lunch,

Visit the economic capital of the country, we will see the interior of the Hassan II Mosque, one of the largest mosques in the world,


A pharaonic work that was paid for by all Moroccans in popular subscription. It is located on the beach near the port to the beach and the medina, and rises majestically topped by its minaret of more than 200 meters of altitude, the highest in the world. At its top, there is a laser beam that marks the direction of Mecca, with a range of 30 km. Continuation to the old Medina, next to the port, is the Medina of Casablanca, of less interest than the other imperial cities, having been destroyed by the 1755 earthquake. Transfer to your hotel. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel,

Breakfast at the hotel, According to the flight departure time, Private transfer to Casablanca airport, Arrival at the airport.
